



High impact resistant helmet for power cut off saw operators

It is well understood, by safety experts, that power cut off saws can recoil out of the cut in a microsecond, even without warning, and when correct cutting techniques are being used.

This unknown, unpredictable hazard, strikes hard with up to 250 kph speeds and up to 25 kg mass. This blow is usually to the forehead and face regions as well as shoulders and neck.

The average hard hat and lightweight vizor combo is simply inadequate protection for operators.

The power cut off saw is considered the most hazardous tool on the construction site with an appalling safety record. There are numerous unreported near miss recoils which operators often mention in passing.

To assist in operator safety Diamond blademan is working with Pacific Helmets of Wanganui to provide this affordable state of the art helmet /vizor combo.
